

Tennessee Nonprofit Arts & Culture Recovery Fund Round 2 (Final Round) Allocations					
Tiered system based on pandemic-related revenue loss because requests/documentated losses of \$37.8M exceed Round 2 available federal funds of \$7.7M.					
These funds from the American Rescue Plan Act are strictly limited to address documented negative economic impacts of the COVID-19 public health emergency. Requests and awards are based on a standard methodology of documented pandemic-related revenue loss and available funds. Request amounts were capped at \$1M even though some applicant documented losses were higher and Round 2 awards were capped at \$750,000. These awards are different from other TN Arts Commission grants awarded based on merit scores by an external panel and available funds.
